# ESSENTIAL SAFETY INFORMATION

## **Tickets**

- To keep everyone safe, we are allowing fewer attendees into the church building to enable us to all stay COVID safe. This means that everyone who wants to attend a Sabbath worship service must have ordered a ticket in advance, via Eventbrite.
- You will receive a ticket to present on your phone (this does not have to be printed) and you will need to show this at the entrance to get in.

## **If You Or Someone You Know Is Experiencing Coronavirus Symptoms**

- Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19 (these are listed on the NHS website) or if you have recently been in contact with someone who has Covid-19.

## Arriving At The Building

- We recommend you arrive as close to 12:00 as possible, there are no areas to wait.
- You may be asked to join a short socially distanced queue before entering.
- Please arrive wearing your mask
- When you arrive at church your ticket will be checked against the register.
- Your temperature will be taken by a greeter, using a non contact thermometer.
- You will be asked to sanitise your hands on entry.
- You will then be directed to a seat. We are asking you to use the plastic chairs, not the padded chairs.
- Families will be seated together
- Our greeters will be able to help you with any questions when you arrive.

## **Toilets**

- The toilets will be open for usage, we ask that you wipe as you go.

## **Cloakrooms**

- To reduce face to face contact, we ask you not to gather in the foyer, but take your seat.
- There are no cloakrooms so please do not bring lots of things with you, (there is limited storage space available). Prams, Wheelchairs and buggies are welcome however.

## **Refreshments**

- We will not be providing refreshments after the service.

## Following Safety Measures

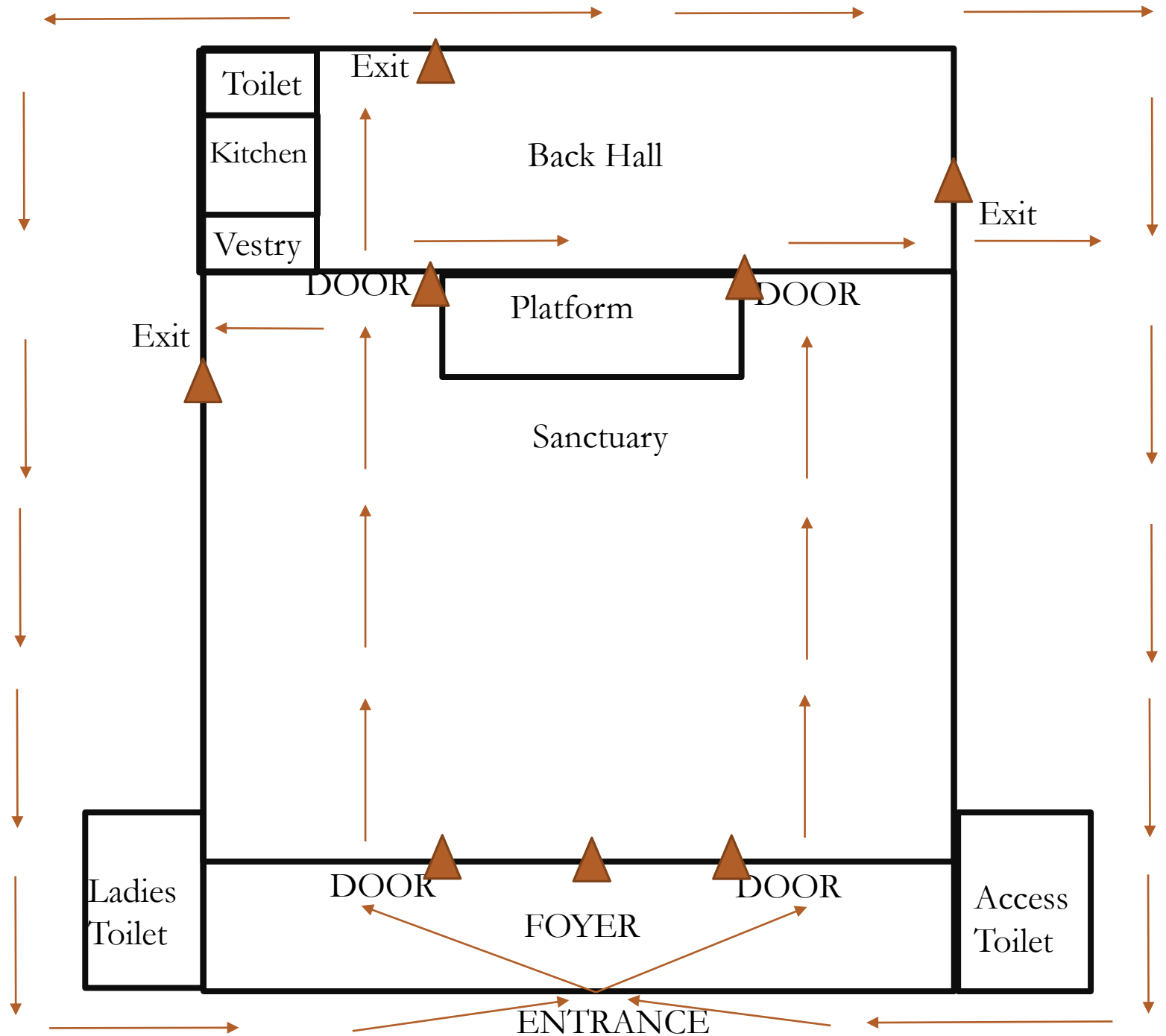
We want you to feel confident and have the best worship experience when you visit, so we ask you to please:

## What We're Doing to Keep People Safe

As we welcome you back, our number one priority is your health and wellbeing. We have introduced a number of measures across the building to help everyone remain safe while they are here. We are following the official Working Safety during Covid-19 Government guidance to make sure the whole building is Covid secure. Measures we have introduced so far include:

- Reduced numbers of attendees
- Clear signage to guide people safely around the building
- Removal of seating and changes to how you access toilets to ensure social distancing
- Hand sanitiser stations at all entrances
- Weekly deep and thorough cleaning of door handles, rails, toilets and other areas
- Asking everyone to wear face coverings while in the building

We will continue to review and manage any risks and to respond to any changes in Government guidance, keeping our duty team trained and up to date as we go
